

Mark Clatworthy is Professor of Accounting and Head of School of Accounting and Finance at the University of Bristol. Before joining Bristol, he was Professor of Accounting at Cardiff University.

Mark earned his PhD in Accounting from Cardiff University (2002). His research interests cover topics in capital market-based accounting research and in audit markets. He has taught MSc, undergraduate, and Ph.D. courses in financial reporting and financial statement analysis.

He has previously served as UK Board Member and Management Committee member of the EAA, including as Chair of the Accounting Resources Centre. He was also previously a member of the Research Panel of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of Scotland.

Mark's research has been published in various academic journals including The Accounting Review, Journal of Accounting and Economics, Journal of Business Finance & Accounting, Accounting and Business Research, Journal of Accounting and Public Policy, British Accounting Review and Accounting in Europe.

He is currently a joint editor in chief of Accounting and Business Research, and he also serves in the editorial boards of the European Accounting Review and Accounting in Europe.
