

Mark Clatworthy is Professor of Accounting at the University of Bristol Business School.

Mark obtained his PhD in Accounting from Cardiff University. His research interests are mainly in the use of accounting information by capital markets and in audit markets. He has taught postgraduate and undergraduate courses in financial reporting and financial statement analysis.

He has previously served as UK Board Member and Management Committee member of the EAA, including as Chair of the Accounting Resources Centre. He was also previously a member of the Research Panel of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of Scotland and of the Academic Panel of the UK Financial Reporting Council.

He is currently a joint editor of Accounting and Business Research, and he also serves in the editorial boards of European Accounting Review and Accounting in Europe.
