

Angela Pettinicchio is an Associate Professor of Accounting at Università Cattolica del Sacro Cuore and an Affiliate Professor of Financial Reporting at SDA Bocconi School of Management. Her research interests focus on auditing, specifically audit quality, audit fees, and financial reporting quality. Angela has published papers in top-ranked international journals, including the European Accounting Review, Journal of Accounting Research, Auditing: A Journal of Practice & Theory, and Journal of Accounting, Auditing & Finance.

She is currently a member of the Editorial Boards of the European Accounting Review, Accounting in Europe, Accounting Forum, International Journal of Accounting, Auditing and Taxation, and Journal of Management and Governance. Angela obtained her Ph.D. in Accounting from Cass Business School (London) and has taught Financial Accounting courses at Cass Business School, City University of London, and London Business School. She teaches Accounting, Financial Statement Analysis, and Financial Reporting courses at the undergraduate and graduate levels, as well as in Executive MBA programs.

Since 2023, Angela has been a part of the Scientific Committee of EARNET (European Auditing Research Network) and is a member of both the Organizational Committee and the Scientific Committee for the EIASM Workshop on Audit Quality. She has also been a part of the Scientific Committee (Auditing Section) at EAA since 2017. At Università Cattolica, Angela is a member of the Research Council and the Council of Directors.
