

Cathy Shakespeare is the Thomas C Jones Associate Dean for Undergraduate Education, the Michael and Joan Sakkinen Faculty Fellow and a Professor of Accounting at the Stephen M. Ross School of Business at the University of Michigan. She has a B.A. in Accounting and Finance from Dublin City University, a Ph.D. in Accounting from the University of Illinois Champaign Urbana and is a fellow of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of Ireland. Her research focuses predominantly on the area of financial instruments, asset securitizations and fair value accounting and has been published in leading academic journals, including the Review of Accounting Studies, the Accounting Review and the Journal of Accounting and Economics. In addition to reviewing on an ad hoc basis for numerous leading academic journals, she serves on the editorial board of several accounting journals and as an editor for the Journal of Business Finance and Accounting. She has served as a member of the Financial Accounting Standards Advisory Council whose function is to advise the Financial Accounting Standards Board (FASB) on issues and priorities and is currently a member of the Accounting Resource Group for the FASB. She has taught a broad range of courses at both the undergraduate and graduate level and currently teaches first-year students an introduction to business course.
