

**Claudia Imperatore** is an Associate Professor in the Department of Accounting at Bocconi University. Her research focuses on corporate governance, including shareholder dynamics between dominant and minority shareholders, the impact of shareholder rights on firms' investment and financing decisions, and executive compensation design.

Her work has been published in leading accounting and management journals, including the *Journal of Accounting and Economics*, *Strategic Management Journal*, *European Accounting Review*, *Journal of Accounting, Auditing & Finance*, and *Journal of Accounting and Public Policy*, among others.

She joined the European Accounting Association (EAA) in 2012 and has regularly participated in the EAA Annual Congress as a presenter (2013, 2016, 2019, 2022–2024) and discussant (2018, 2022, 2024). From 2020 to 2022, she served on the Scientific Committee of the EAA Annual Congress, where she was responsible for reviewing submitted papers.

She currently serves as Chair of the Accounting Resources Center (ARC), an EAA initiative aimed at collecting and disseminating research and teaching resources among its members. In this role, she has been invited to speak at the EAA PhD Forum during recent EAA Annual Congresses.

She is also an active member of the American Accounting Association (AAA), particularly within the International Accounting Section (IAS) and the Financial Accounting and Reporting Section (FARS). She has served as the AAA International Section's Liaison to Italy, facilitating the international engagement of Italy-based academics in AAA activities.

Claudia serves on the editorial boards of *European Accounting Review*, *Corporate Governance: An International Review*, *Journal of Business Finance & Accounting*, and *Accounting and Business Research*.
