Research Evaluation



Two models for research evaluation:

- <u>Decentralized (C-markets)</u>: The evaluation processes heavily rely on your "equals":
 - Peer-evaluation process
 - Individuals/Departments
 - University
- Centralized (R-markets)
 - Highly regulated.

Academic Markets (Frey and Eichenberger, 1992, 1993)

C-Market

- Promotion based on number and impact of publications
- Scholars' salaries linked to research productivity
- Large, uniform, and competitive.
- Impersonal.
- Reliable indicators of an individual scholar's quality
- High mobility of academics
- Competition between academic institutions

R-Market

- Promotion decisions based on external (non-research) factors as services, belonging to an school of thought, etc.
- Research evaluation systems are unclear.
- Thin and incomplete: Fewer professors and universities.
- Regulated. Government intervention.
- Characterized by:
 - Professors are <u>public officials</u> with life tenure in exchange of good conduct.
 - Low mobility of both students and academics
 - Various languages pose natural barriers to entry.
- Weak competition between academic institutions
