

## INTERNATIONAL ACCESSIBILITY

Cyprus is served by two International Airports; Larnaca International Airport (LCA), and Paphos International Airport (PFO). More than 80 International Airlines connect Cyprus to the whole world; for more details regarding flights to/from Cyprus, please visit the official website of both airports at <a href="https://www.hermesairports.com">www.hermesairports.com</a>. Furthermore, domestic communication between both airports and all the major cities on the island is very quick and easy via an extensive highway system.

Major airlines and low cost carriers connect the two international airports on the island with all continents. Most Major European cities like London, Frankfurt and Vienna have daily direct connections (on most days more than one connections), and major international cities like Sidney, Tokyo, Beijing, New York and San Francisco connect with Cyprus with only one stop over.
