The **DIBT** - **Doctoral Program** in **International Business Taxation** at **WU Vienna** offers an outstanding **PhD program** designed for exceptional students from around the world. DIBT focuses on interdisciplinary research and training, combining **tax accounting**, **public finance and international tax law**, to equip students with a comprehensive understanding of **international business taxation**.

## **CONTENT AND STRUCTURE**

The DIBT is structured to provide a solid foundation for multidisciplinary research:

- ✓ <u>Year 1:</u> Intensive courses to develop fundamental knowledge for research in both specific and interdisciplinary contexts.
- ✓ Years 2 & 3: Seminars on taxation perspectives, research stay abroad, optional workshops, and especially dedicated thesis work, all complemented by a continuous research seminar.

All courses are taught in **English**.
